- Earned PhD in Social Work or related field
- Eligibility for a tenured appointment
- Established program of research, with a progressive track record of external funding
- A record of successfully managing funded research projects
- A strong record of scholarly journal publications

Preferred qualifications

Preferred qualifications for assistant professor position are:

- Masters of Social Work (MSW) Degree (if from international university, applicant must send in letter of equivalency from CSWE)
- Two years of post-MSW practice experience
- Teaching and mentoring experience, with the ability to teach in the tracks emphasized above
- Ability and interest in teaching online courses

Preferred qualifications for associate/full professor are:

- Established program of research with significant federal funding
- A strong record of participating in interdisciplinary research work
- A strong record of teaching and mentoring
