Learning Agreement Purpose Statement

The Learning Agreement serves as a comprehensive guide for the student's learning experience during their practicum at the agency. It encompasses the MSW Specialization Year's nine social work competencies, further expanded and enhanced by the program's specialized practice areas, incorporating additional competencies. This approach provides master's-level students with a well-rounded understanding of knowledge, values, skills, and cognitive and affective processes relevant to their chosen specialized practice area. Like the Generalist Year, students are responsible for developing specific and personalized learning activities within each extended competency, integrating the abovementioned dimensions. The agency's opportunities shape these activities and tasks, the student's individual learning needs, interests, and preferences, and the practice competencies mandated by the School of Social Work and the [2022 CSWE Educational Policy and Accreditation Standards](#). The activities are site-specific, measurable, and tailored to promote the student's successful development of professional competencies across various domains.

The Learning Agreement should be finalized **by week four of the semester** via the student's Sonia account. It will be reviewed by the AFI, the Field Liaison, and the student throughout the practicum's three site visits. It also serves as the basis for assessing practicum performance and progress throughout the academic year and for the student's final practicum grade (credit/ no credit) at the end of the overall practicum experience. Development towards the individual competencies is assessed during a mid-term and a final evaluation. Consequently, students should regularly review and update their learning agreement and activities to ensure it reflects changes made or new learning and opportunities.
